ANNUAL REPORT (1-4-2004 to 31-3-2005)



The audit was very voluminous and was completed as per the schedule laid down by us.


2. Total Collections: During the last four years immediately preceding the current year the total collections of the Foundation was as under:




3. Medical help to cancer patients: During this period we have helped 546 poor cancer patients covering about 74 hospitals all over India to the tune of Rs.81,12,800/-. This is almost twice the amount distributed in the preceding year. During the current year, we hope to help more than 600 patients with aggregate assistance in excess of Rs. 1 crore. 
