ANNUAL REPORT (1-4-2004 to 31-3-2005)

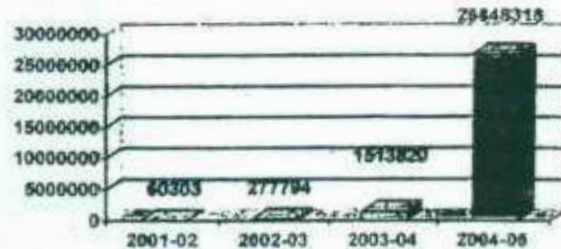
It is my great pleasure to present to you the annual report of the activities of the Cancer Aid & Research Foundation for the period ending 31st March 2005. The annual audit of the Foundation for the period ended on 31st March 2005 was completed in the month of June 2005. The following activities were undertaken during this period by the Foundation:-

1. **Audit:-** Our accounts for the period ended on 31st March 2005 have been audited by M/s. A.O. Bhamla & Co., Chartered Accountants, Mumbai - 400 003 and they have issued us the audit report to that effect.

The audit was very voluminous and was completed as per the schedule laid down by us.

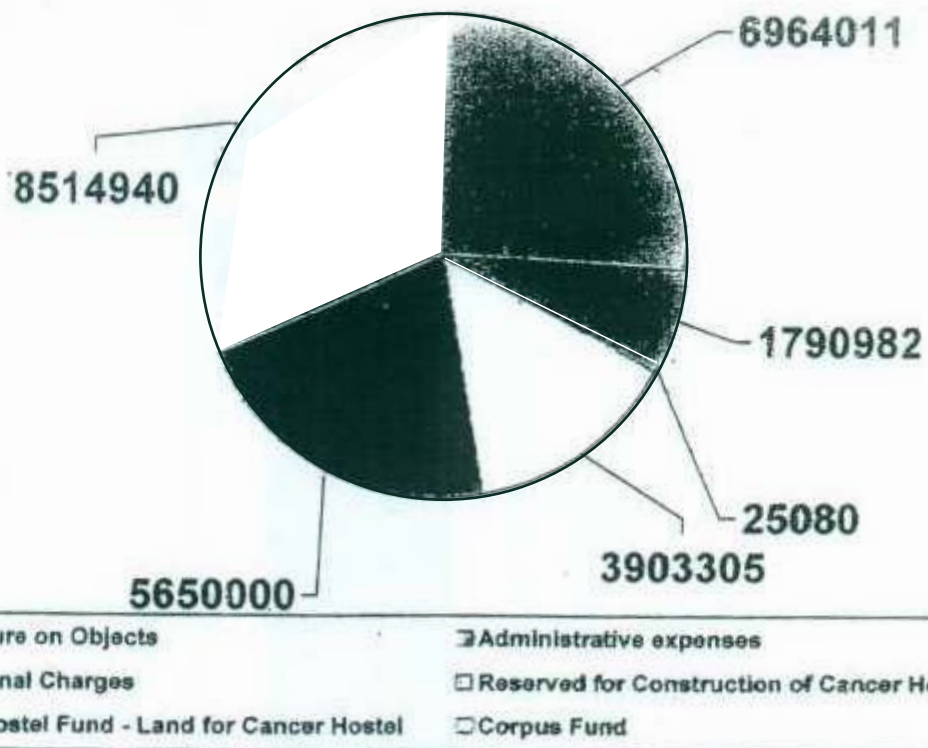
2. **Total Collections:** During the last four years immediately preceding the current year the total collections of the Foundation was as under:

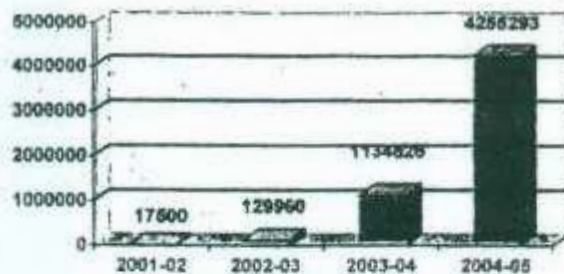

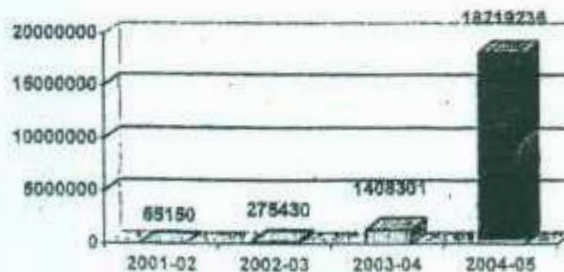
3. **Medical help to cancer patients:-** During this period we have helped 546 poor cancer patients covering about 74 hospitals all over India to the tune of Rs.81,12,800/-. This is almost twice the amount distributed in the preceding year. During the current year, we hope to help more than 600 patients with aggregate assistance in excess of Rs. 1 crore. The following table will give you a view of help provided to cancer patients during the last few years.

5. **Publication:-** I must bring it to your notice that just extending financial help to the cancer patients is not the only purpose of the foundation. Equally important is the creation of public awareness among the people about this dreaded disease that is rampant in India

For this purpose, we periodically publish leaflets on Cancer for educating the people and send them to all those who are on our mailing list. So far 2 such leaflets have been published by the foundation.

Besides this we have now regularly started publishing our own quarterly news letter - 'CAF News Bulletin.' So far 6 issues are out and they have been highly appreciated by the medical fraternity. Our compliments to the Chief Editor - Dr. Rehan A. Kazi for his excellent work done so far.
