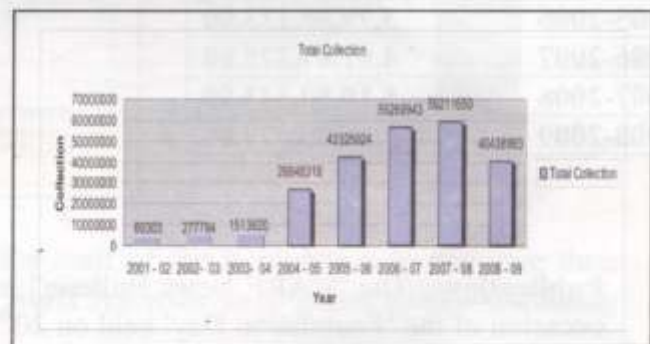

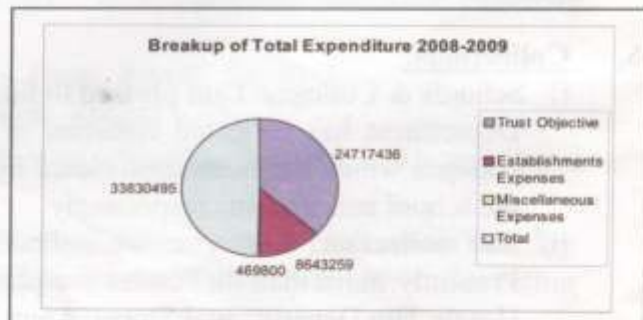

BREAKUP OF TOTAL EXPENDITURE 2008 – 2009.

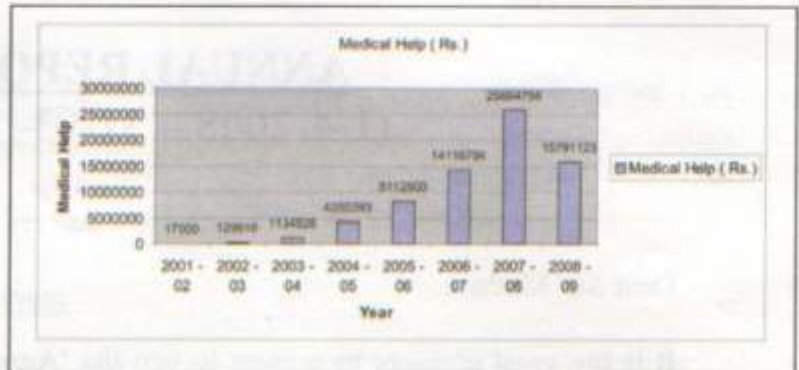

During the year 2008 – 2009, the global economic recession affected us also, resulting in lower collection.

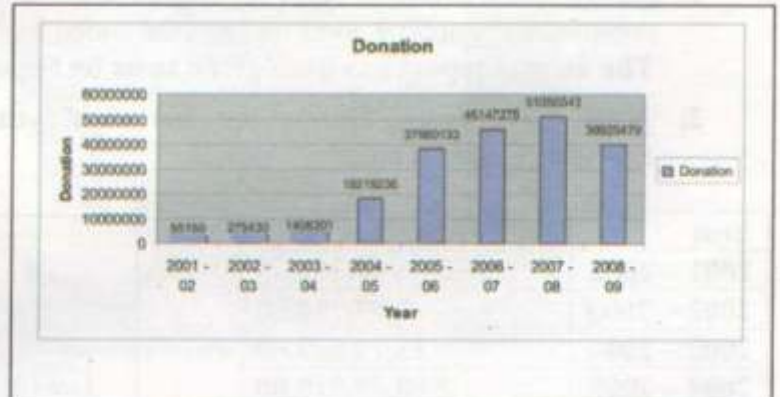
3. **Medical help to poor cancer patients:** The following table will give you a bird's eye view of help provided to poor cancer patients during the last eight years:

9. Celebration of Rose Day:



World Rose Day function was held by Publicity & Publication Department of CARF at Sir. J.J Group of Hospitals, Mumbai on 22nd September 2008. Every year we celebrate this day with cancer patients. This year CARF celebrated the function with the children admitted in the Pediatric ward of the Hospital. Dr. Raj Tendulkar, Dr. (Mrs.) N. R Sutay, RMO's and other hospital staff along with 130 patients and PPD staff were present for the function. On this occasion CARF distributed toys, biscuits and roses to all patients admitted in the Pediatric Ward no.37, 38, 39, 40, NICU AND PICU ward. Thus, our motto to bring smiles on those small children's faces was achieved.

10. Kokan Cancer Hospital – Project Status:-



The Foundation has been allotted five acres of land at MIDC, Ratnagiri for construction of the CARF Cancer Hospital. An additional five acres of land has also been sanctioned subsequently. The architects plan for this project includes a diagnostic centre, cancer hospital, hostel and medical staff quarters. A part of the civil construction and electrical work has been completed at the site.

Till date, about 5 crores have been invested by CARF in this project. Mobilization of funds for this project had slowed down during the last one year due to the global economic recession. Consequently, the work had to be stopped temporarily.

However we are hopeful that the work on the project would be recommenced shortly, once financial aid is received from certain sources. We understand that the CARF Ratnagiri Project has been included by the Al Maktoum Foundation , Dubai for financing in their budget of 2009- 2010. However, the actual amount and date of possible disbursement of the aid is not yet known. We feel it would be before end 2009. We have also approached the Ministry of Health at New Delhi for allocation of funds under the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) for the CARF Hospital Project. Our trustee Dr. Raj Tendulkar is pursuing the matter and we are hopeful of being allocated some amount. Also, we have approached the Government of Maharashtra for financial assistance for this project. The proposal has been forwarded to the Chief Minister Shri. Ashok Chavan and we are hopeful to receive a favourable response. Based on the above, we hope to recommence the construction work by December, 2009.

Kazi has been awarded the title of 'CSci (Chartered Scientist – UK)' in 2009 by the Institute of Clinical Research and Science Council, UK. I am pleased to inform you that the Foundation had organized its third Annual CARF Oration on 4th October, 2008, at Sachivalaya Gymkhana, Mumbai. The Hon'ble speaker on the occasion was Dr. Praful B. Desai, Consultant Cancer Surgeon, Former Director & Chief of Surgery, Tata Memorial Hospital and UICC role of Honour. Dr. Praful B. Desai's oration on 'Medicine Science and Religion'

was received with rapt attention by the audience. It was attended by doctors, donors and the press.

13. Life Members:

Cancer Aid & Research Foundation has enrolled a total number of 23 Life Members since its commencement. The Life members are entitled to collect donations, advertisement, sponsorships etc. for the Foundation. The Life Membership fees has been revised from Rs. 5000/- to Rs. 10000/-.
