SURVIVOR STORY OF MANSI

Cancer is one of the most dreaded diseases in the world, but it is curable and not the end of life. One of the survivor's story is of Mansi Raju More. At the age of 10, all of a sudden she developed symptoms of swelling around her joints, her glands were swollen, accompanied by severe abdominal pain. After being treated by local doctors, there was no sign of improvement in her condition. Mansi's parents drove from their residence in Thane and brought her to a clinic. A spinal tap was done which did not reveal the disease. Doctors were looking for juvenile rheumatoid arthritis or lupus, but after blood test it was diagnosed that the child is suffering from blood cancer. Doctors immediately shifted her to Wadia Hospital where once again blood and PET CT Scan investigations started. She was hospitalized as swelling in her stomach was increasing, and the doctors

swelling in her stomach was increasing, and the doctors started with antibiotics and I.V. fluids, nasopharynx tube was also inserted. Her condition was extremely serious as there was no sign of improvement in her condition. But eventually the will of God came forth and she showed signs of improvement. After her condition stabilized, infection was under control and her treatment plan was decided by the doctors.

Her treatment plan was that, she will require chemotherapy and maintenance phase. Her parents were very disturbed and got worried thinking of the huge amount that was needed to get their daughter cured. Through hospital sources & well wishers they came to know about **CARF**. When they approached CARF, her parents were first counseled, and necessary monetary and financial help was given. They felt motivated and a ray of hope sparkled in their life. Gradually the treatment planned by doctors worked and Mansi's condition showed improvement day by day. She is completely cured now and back on her feet.








